On 30 November millions will strike to defend pensions



The government is forcing public sector workers to pay more towards their pensions just as they are being made to work longer. It is part of the government's plan to make ordinary people pay for a crisis made by the bankers.

The real division in Britain is not between public and private sector but between the rich and the rest of us.

Already pensions for top company directors average £174,963 a year, while public service pensions average £7,800 a year.

As Europe faces economic meltdown, cuts will make Britain more unequal and force us back in to recession.
